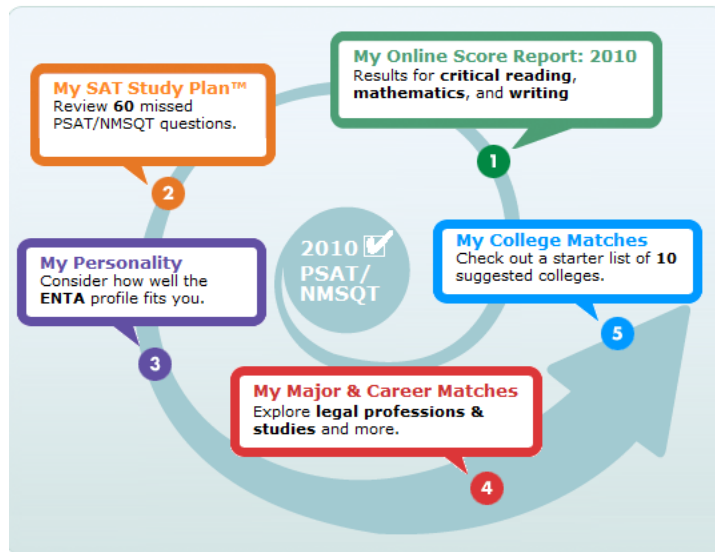


PSAT – MY COLLEGE QUICKSTART

1. Go to www.collegeboard.org/quickstart.
2. Enter your online access code from your paper score report.
3. If you have a College Board account, enter your username and password. If you don't have an account, create one by clicking **Sign Up**. **Steps to complete** creating your account:
 - Step 1: Complete those fields where a red asterisk appears (*)
 - Step 2: Collects parent information. Complete this section if you'd like a parent to receive e-mail communications from the College Board. Please note that your parent will need to accept the e-mail confirmation notice from the College Board prior to receiving any e-mails.
 - Step 3: Create a user name and password and select a security question and answer. Select items that you can easily remember but aren't easily guessed by others.
 - Step 4: Tell us who is completing this form.Click **SUBMIT**
4. Once account is created, under My QuickStart, in the field **Test Year**, enter the year you took the test. Click the **Submit** button. Based on your account information and your entered access code, the system searches the database for the same matching criteria to securely connect you to your score information. If you match securely, you will be presented with your My College QuickStart home page.

My College QuickStart:

1. **My Online Score Report**—an enhanced score report that allows you to review each test question, your answers, and the correct answers with answer explanations
2. **My SAT Study Plan**—a customized SAT study plan based on your PSAT/NMSQT test performance, with hundreds of practice questions to help improve your skills
3. **My Personality**—a detailed personality test that helps you learn about themselves and discover majors and careers that fit your strengths and interests
4. **My Major & Career Matches**—extensive information about majors and careers, including insights about what to expect and what courses to take now
5. **My College Matches**—a starter list of colleges based on your home state and indicated choice of major

My Online Score Report:

- Click on **My Online Score Report**
- Shows your scores and how you compared to others for Critical Reading, Math and Writing (see tabs)
- **Your Skills:** Shows strengths and weaknesses. Click on links for more information, including how you answered questions in those sections.
- **Your Answers:** Shows Correct Answer, Your Answer, Difficulty-level and Skill used. Click on Question # to see actual question, potential answers and explanations.

My SAT Study Plan:

- Based on PSAT scores for Critical Reading, Math and Writing, review questions missed or omitted, use resources and options to prepare for the SAT, compare the SAT to PSAT, take practice SAT, etc.

My Personality:

- Take this assessment to help understand strengths, motivations, optimal learning environments, social interactions and interests to explore majors and careers that match your personality type and interests.

My Major and Career Matches:

- Explore major and career profiles, read firsthand accounts from students and professionals, and learn about required skills and academic preparations.

My College Matches:

- Automatically generates list of colleges that match preferred major and home state – can be customized and links to specific colleges for information on admissions, etc.
