Examples of Volunteer Roles & Responsibilities

The descriptions below are examples of volunteer responsibilities. Committee Chairs plan and organize volunteers based on the event's specific needs. While most volunteers are needed at the time of an event, some chairs need support with preparation which can be more flexible. Many of these events require only a 1 – 2 hour commitment.
